



Imaging the Heart

The next non-invasive imaging meeting will take place on 19th January, 2012. Everyone with an interest in any modality of non-invasive cardiac imaging is welcome.

The aim of the meeting is twofold;

- To share current knowledge in an increasingly wide range of available non-invasive imaging modalities including echocardiography, cardiovascular magnetic resonance imaging, nuclear imaging & multi-slice CT.
- To act as a forum for the discussion of difficult cases often requiring multi-modality imaging.

The meeting will take place on Thursday 19th January, 2012 in Shu, Lisburn Road, Belfast starting at 7.00pm. Again, the planned format is for 3 short presentations followed by an 'open floor' session for discussion of interesting/difficult cases.
